A Message from Dr. Dennis Episcopo,

Ephesians 5 tells us that we are to be "imitators" of God.

Imitate God, therefore, in everything you do, because you are his dear children. Live a life filled with love, following the example of Christ. He loved us and offered himself as a sacrifice for us, a pleasing aroma to God. Let there be no sexual immorality, impurity, or greed among you...You can be sure that no immoral, impure, or greedy person will inherit the Kingdom of Christ and of God. For a greedy person is an idolater, worshiping the things of this world. (Eph. 5:1-5)

So how do we imitate God according to those verses? Clearly, one way to imitate God is by being generous as He showed us on the cross, sacrificing everything for us. Whenever you act in a generous way, you imitate God because your generosity is God-like.
